SKI TRIVIA: WORLD'S SNOWIEST SKI RESORTS

- 1: Washington's Mt. Baker with 650". (They had 95feet of snow in the 1998-1999 ski season!)
- 2: Niseko, on Hokkaido, Japan's northernmost island, with 595" per year. That's almost 50feet!
- 3: Alta, Utah, which averaged 523" per year.
- 4: Alyeska, Alaska, with 513". (The resort had already hit 200" of snow by December 2, this season).
- 5: Kirkwood, California, just south of Lake Tahoe, with 473".
