Vermont Ski Areas Offer Deals for 2009-10 Season

With current economic conditions prompting many northeasterners to ski closer to home, Vermont ski resorts have announced a multitude of savings opportunities ranging from season pass specials to cut-rate days. Here's a partial list:

Bromley's Sun Mountain Club Card was created to reward skiers and riders who visit often but not often enough to justify the purchase of a season pass. The card costs \$69 for adults, \$59 for teens and seniors (65-69), and \$49 for juniors and super seniors (70+). It comes loaded with one free day of skiing, \$10 off every all-day lift ticket, weekends and holidays included, plus if purchased by Oct. 10, \$20 off one purchase at the Bromley Shop. The Sun Mountain Club Card may be purchased at www.bromley.com or at the ticket booth.

Not only does **Magic Mountain** offer some of southern Vermont's most challenging ski terrain, it also offers the discount savvy skier or rider a multitude of options for further discounts. On non-holiday Wednesdays throughout the season, guests to Magic Mountain can car pool (at least four people per car) with friends and family and receive lift tickets for \$80 per car. Skiers and riders who come to the slopes of Magic Mountain with at least three of their friends or family midweek non-holiday can take advantage of \$25 lift tickets all season long. With a Magic Mountain Season Pass, ski or ride all season long with no restrictions for only \$379 if purchased before Oct. 1 and \$419 if purchased after that date.

Also, the **\$39 Magic Card** offers discounts on lift tickets all season, featuring \$25 midweek lift tickets and \$10 off all weekends and holidays.

Mount Snow's Nor'Easter pass provides access to all Peak Resorts ski areas in the Northeast, including Mount Snow in Vermont as well as New Hampshire's Attitash and Crotched Mountain. The Nor'Easter has no blackout dates and it offers 20% off at all retail outlets and access to first tracks early lift access. For those lucky enough to get to the slopes on weekdays, Mount Snow's Midweek pass is the way to go. As always, kids 5 and under ski free.

Mount Snow's \$99 FANfare card offers 50% off midweek non-holiday lift tickets, 25% off weekend non-holiday tickets and 10% off holiday tickets, all season long.

New for 2009-2010, **Okemo** is introducing a Sunday-only season pass priced at \$299 for adults when purchased prior to Oct. 12.

Pico Mountain skiers and riders will receive discounts of up to \$16 per day off regular ticket window prices with the Pico Card. Pico cards are available for \$24 and are valid everyday of the 2009-10 ski and snowboard season.
